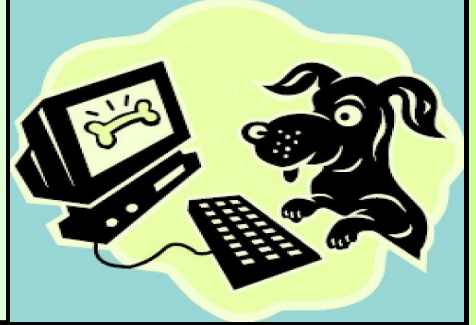




HOUND PARISH COUNCIL NEWSLETTER NEWSHOUND SUMMER 2017



Over the past few months there have been some changes happening at Hound Parish Council that we would like to share with you.

In November 2016 we appointed David Nevin to the position of Parish Clerk. "I am excited to be involved with the positive changes that Hound Parish Council are making" said David.

In May 2017 Hound Parish Council appointed a new Chair. Cllr Mark Roberts took over from Cllr Mrs Maureen Queen. Mark, a local businessman has served as a councillor for 2 years in Hound "As a local Netley resident who is active within the school community, I would like to think that I am able to offer a fresh perspective as to what Netley's younger residents need their community to offer" said Mark.

In June 2017 HPC approved a new logo for the council. which more appropriately reflects Netley's rich heritage. The new logo features the famous window from Netley Abbey and St Mary's Church. The new logo will be phased in over the next year.

Hound Parish Council has also made some important changes to it's technology platforms. They have moved from a Windows operating system to Google and also joined the .GOV domain. These changes will offer HPC a more secure technological base in which to operate.

The next step in technology will be with the introduction of a new Hound Parish Council website. Using the .GOV domain, the new website aims to be more user friendly than the current site. The new website will be online later on in 2017.

Wasted appointments

During the month of May 2017 a total of 188 appointments were not attended which had not been cancelled by patients.

We are trying to cut down on this by encouraging patients to cancel when they cannot attend, which will free up appointments for other patients.

We are installing a new text messaging service called MJOG for or patients on 16th June 2017.

On or shortly after this date, patients with a mobile number recorded will receive a text message giving them the opportunity to opt in or out of this system as they wish. This new system will give you them opportunity to cancel appointments by text.

Patients can also cancel on line (if they are Registered for Patient Access), or by calling the Health Centre and choosing option 4 (no don't need to wait for a Receptionist – simply leave a message).
